Entry Fees

First entry is \$20.00 per day; second entry of same dog, same day is \$10.00. Each entry of each dog includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee. Catalogs may be pre-ordered for \$7 on the entry form. A limited number will be available at the trial for \$10.

A refund of entry fees, less judging fees, will be given for any bitch that comes into season, and a refund of entry fees, less AKC fees and judging fees, will be given for any dog or handler that is injured or ill, **if written notification is provided to the Trial Secretary prior to the beginning of judging for the day.** Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate, provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

****Please designate the dog's breed as "All American" on the entry form.****

Vendor Information

Vendors, including photographers, are welcome at our trials, but need to apply for booth space and sign a liability waiver. Booth space is \$20 for the weekend for a 10' x 10' space, \$25 for 10' x 20'. Vendor areas will not be immediately adjacent to the rings, in order to minimize congestion at ringside. We will be using white boards for worker sign-up at the trial, but if you would like to be scheduled ahead of time as a Course Builder, Scribe, or Timer, please send in the volunteer form with your entry. Lunch will be provided for workers doing two or more classes in a day. Thank you for your help; we couldn't do it without you!

Important Information for Exhibitors -- PLEASE READ!

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, illegible, telephone, fax, e-mail or telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC forms, or photocopies of AKC forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form, are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, regardless of who makes such errors. Dogs wrongly entered in a class may not be transferred to another class after closing.

Entries sent by express mailing services MUST have the delivery signature requirement waived; otherwise they may not be delivered on time. The secretary will not pick up entries being held for signature, and no entries will be considered as being received until they are delivered.

Please note the opening date of July 2, 2010; no entries will be accepted before that date. Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in one envelope; envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be considered invalid, and will be returned to the sender. No hand delivered entries can be accepted until 8:00 AM on July 3, 2010.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, or in the event a dog is absent (other than as specified on page 2), disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Confirmation of entry and schedule of judging time will be e-mailed (or sent by postal mail to the address on the official AKC entry form, if no e-mail is provided) after the closing date; if not received at least seven days prior to the show, contact the Trial Secretary. **Acknowledgment of receipt of entries prior to closing will be provided if the exhibitor provides a valid e-mail address on the entry form, or includes a stamped, self-addressed postcard with entry.**

Security personnel will be present at the trial site overnight. However, Spokane Dog Training Club, Inc. assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site and no refund of any fees paid will be made.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or designated warm-up area.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

The safety of dogs is of primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Judging

Judging starts at 2:30 PM on Friday, and at 8:00 a.m. on both Saturday and Sunday. Judge's briefing and course walk-through will take place prior to that time.

-- On Friday, the first class will be Excellent FAST, followed by Excellent JWW and then Excellent Standard. Rings will run alternately.

-- On Saturday, standard classes and Novice FAST will be in Ring 1; JWW classes and Open and Excellent FAST will be in Ring 2. Rings will run concurrently.

-- On Sunday, Ring 1 will start with standard classes, then FAST. Ring 2 will start with JWW, then FAST. Rings will run concurrently.

Running order within divisions will be determined by random draw, except that multiple dogs handled by the same person will be separated wherever possible. Preferred Class dogs will generally run at the end of each height.

Site Information and Obstacles

These Agility Trials will be held outdoors on grass, ring size 100' by 100'. Two rings will be used, one for standard classes and one for JWW. Water and portable toilets are on site. Please be prepared to provide shade for your dogs, as there is no shade on site. And of course, we know you will uphold the great reputation of agility exhibitors by cleaning up after your dogs! Obstacles used will meet the specifications given in the current AKC regulations. Weave poles have 23" spacing.

Move-Up Information

Dogs that have completed an agility title at an earlier event may be moved up to a higher class. The handler must make the request to the Trial Secretary in writing (e-mail is acceptable) by 6:00 PM on **Monday, August 23, 2010**. If a dog finishes a title during the trial, the handler may move up for the following days by turning in a move-up form to the Trial Secretary within 1/2 hour of the end of judging for the day.

Measuring

Sue Fregien is a Volunteer Measuring Official, so measurements at these trials will be official for your jump height card if your dog is at least 2 years old.

Directions to Show

From the west, take I-90 to the Pines exit (#289) and go north (turn left off the exit ramp) on Pines 1.2 miles to Trent. Turn right on Trent, go 1.8 miles to Progress Road. Turn left on Progress and go approximately one-half mile to the school grounds, which are between Sullivan Road and Progress Road on the north side of Wellesley. Motor homes turn right on Wellesley, then left into the large driveway; cars continue on Progress Road across Wellesley and go to the parking lot entrance.

From the east, take I-90 to the Sullivan Road North exit (#291B) and go north (turn right off the exit ramp) on Sullivan 2 miles to Wellesley Avenue (4 way stop). Turn left on Wellesley; the school grounds are between Sullivan Road and Progress Road on the north side of Wellesley. Motor homes enter from Wellesley; cars continue to Progress Road, turn right and go to the parking lot entrance.

Questions??

If you are unsure of which class or division to enter, please **ASK** the Trial Secretary, so that you do not end up entered incorrectly and lose the chance to qualify! **Please keep in mind that if you or your dog has earned any AKC Agility title, you can NOT be entered in Novice A in any agility class!** Dogs entered in Novice A must be handled by the owner, co-owner or a member of the owner's household and that person must not have earned an AKC agility title on any dog. You can NOT change your entry after the closing date, except to move to a higher level (e.g. Novice to Open).

Height Divisions

The following jump height divisions shall be used in all trial classes:

Regular	Preferred	
8"	4"	For dogs 11 inches and under at the withers.
12"	8"	For dogs 14 inches and under at the withers.
16"	12"	For dogs 18 inches and under at the withers.
20"	16"	For dogs 22 inches and under at the withers.
24"	20"	For dogs over 22 inches at the withers.
26"	---	Dogs may be entered at this height at owner's discretion.

In the Regular classes, handlers may choose to run in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In the Preferred classes, dogs may NOT run in a higher height division than that determined by their withers height.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

How do I know if I have a valid jump height card?

If your dog is under the age of two years as of the trial's date: One (1) temporary measurement is required. Once measured, be sure to retain the Agility Measurement Form yellow copy and check "My dog has a **Temporary** Jump Height Form" box, otherwise your dog needs to be measured. If your dog turns two years of age or is older as of the trial's date, your temporary measurement expires on their 2nd birthday and your dog needs to be measured.

If your dog is the age of two years or older as of the trial's date: A minimum of two (2) permanent measurements are required. If both permanent measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, the AKC office will issue you a permanent card. If not, then a third measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class. Until such time that you have received all required measurements for a permanent jump height card, check the "My dog needs to be measured" box. Upon arrival at the trial, you must check to see if there is a Volunteer Measuring Official and/or an Agility Field Rep. present to perform official measurements. If not, and you possess a yellow copy of the Agility Measurement Form from a previous measurement, then your armband may be picked up during Check-In in lieu of being measured by the judge of record. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

Exception to the 2 permanent measurement requirement: If your dog measures over 22 inches at the withers, you have the option of selecting the "Over 22" Reqst Perm" box at the top left corner of the Agility Measurement Form to receive a permanent jump height card from AKC after a single measurement. If you do so, please also sign below the checkbox. By doing so, you are giving up your right to have a 2nd measurement performed on your dog in the future; however, you are not giving up your right to have the challenge measurement process performed in the future. Once you have received your permanent card from the AKC office, check the "My dog has a **Permanent** Jump Height Card" box on all future entry forms.

What if my dog measures into a different jump height than what he is entered?

If your dog has been measured by an AKC Field Representative or Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) and is now eligible to jump in a lower height class, the measurement is effective immediately, including any runs (regular or preferred class) which have not yet occurred on the same day that the measurement is recorded. This immediate action does not apply to measurements taken as part of completing the challenge measurement process. Dogs who measure into a higher jump height have always been required to be moved immediately.

May I challenge my dog's jump height card measurement?

Yes, each dog may go through the challenge process once after the age of two (2) years, if requested by the owner. (Any dogs under the age of two (2) years are also eligible for a challenge measurement.)

What is the jump height card challenge process?

The jump height card challenge process replicates the original measurement steps. A minimum of two (2) challenge measurements are required. If both challenge measurements place your dog into the same jump height class, then you will be issued a new permanent card from the AKC office. If the two challenge measurements place the dog in different jump height classes, then a third challenge measurement is required to determine the dog's jump height class.

Until such time that you have received all required challenge measurements, you must continue to compete at the original jump height stated on the permanent jump height card that is in your possession.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. Additionally, if a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running. *Regulations for Agility Trials, Chapter 2, Section 4.*

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place in each height division in each Regular and each Preferred class.

Dark green ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. First place in each height division of each class will receive a dog toy, valued at \$1 to \$5.

Within each Standard Agility class, JWW class and FAST class, the dog earning the highest score will receive a Rosette, and a Certificate good for a \$10 discount on one entry to any Spokane Dog Training Club AKC agility trial in 2011 or 2012. In the case of tied scores, the dog with the fastest **yards per second** running time wins. There will be separate High in Class awards for the Preferred classes. There will not be High in Trial awards at these trials.

A title pin will be awarded to each dog completing a standard or JWW agility title (NA, NAP, OA, OAP, AX, AXP, MX, MXP, NAJ, NJP, OAJ, OJP, AXJ, AJP, MXJ, MJP, MACH, PAX) at either of these trials. A Rosette and jump bar will be awarded to any dog completing a MACH or PAX at either of these trials. A qualifying score is required for all awards. All awards must be claimed at the show; none will be mailed.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial **or back-to-back trials** only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. **Mixed breed dogs** entered in these events must list the breed name as "All American Dog" (mixed breed) and not as a breed hybrid and **must** include their AKC Canine Partners number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
