**CLOSING DATE for these tests is Wednesday, July 12, 2017, 5:00 p.m., after which time entries cannot be accepted.**

**ENTRY FEE: VST: \$125, TDU: \$75 (US funds) which includes a .50 AKC Recording Fee and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Fees must accompany all entries. Make checks or money orders payable to SDTC. Mail entries and fees to: Rosemary Petersen, Test Secretary, 10526 North Overview Drive, Spokane, WA 99217. Only one AKC entry form will be accepted for each dog.**

OWNERS are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

All entries will be accepted until the official closing date. A DRAWING will be held at the Spokane Dog Training Club, 2620 N. Locust, Spokane, Washington, on July 12th, at 6:30 p.m. to determine which entries will participate in the test. **The drawing will be random among those entries received, except that preference will be given to dogs that have not previously earned any tracking title.**

All persons submitting entries are invited to attend the drawing.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, an ALTERNATE list will be drawn subject to the same preferences set forth above. The alternates will be advised of their positions on the alternate list and given an opportunity to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternate entry fees will be refunded unless the alternate actually participates in the test. Entry fees will also be refunded to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. If the LIMIT FOR ENTRIES is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TDU equals 1 VST.

**A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test (TDU) for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test, certifying that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test that is equivalent in complexity to a TD or TDU test.**

RESULTS OF THE DRAW will be e-mailed, the morning after the draw, to entrants who give an e-mail address on their entry form. WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS and the Judging Program will also be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, **please notify the Test Secretary by e-mail at rosemarynron@comcast.net, or (509)466-8002.**

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate. The Test Secretary must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. These dogs will be given the last tracks and will not be allowed in the tracking area until just prior to running their tracks.

THE TRACKING TEST SITE ("Site") will open at 5:00 a.m., July 23, 2017 Refreshments will be furnished. The DRAWING FOR TDU TRACKS will be at 6:00 a.m. The DRAWING FOR VST TRACKS will be at 8:00 a.m. The first track will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentee(s) among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

The test will be held on school campuses.

BY THEIR PRESENCE at the Site, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Test Committee and Judges. AWARDS: All competitors who pass this test will be awarded their tracking glove and a 5-window picture frame with pictures of their dog.

**DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACKING SITE:** The major interstate connecting Seattle and Spokane is I-90. Westbound from Spokane, take I-90 to the Four Lakes/Cheney Exit #270. Take Hwy 904 (Lt. Col. Michael P. Anderson Memorial Highway) 4.8 miles to Betz Road. Turn right on Betz Road and go 2.5 miles. (Betz Road will make a left turn and become Washington Street.) Sutton Park is on the left at West 7th Avenue on the south end of the Eastern Washington University campus. Eastbound from Seattle/Ritzville, take I-90 to the Tyler/Cheney Exit #257.
