CLOSING DATE for these tests is Wednesday, September 12, 2018, 5:00 p.m., after which time entries cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEE: VST: \$125, TDU: \$75 (US funds) which includes a .50 AKC Recording Fee and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Fees must accompany all entries. Make checks or money orders payable to SDTC. Mail entries and fees to: Claudette Longoria, Test Secretary, 3804 West Lyons Avenue, Spokane, WA 99208-4832. Only one AKC entry form will be accepted for each dog.

OWNERS are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

All entries will be accepted until the official closing date. A DRAWING will be held at the Spokane Dog Training Club, 2620 N. Locust, Spokane, Washington, on September 12th, at 6:30 p.m. to determine which entries will participate in the test. **The drawing will be random among those entries received, except that preference will be given to dogs that have not previously earned any tracking title.**

Dogs not holding any tracking title will be given priority for entry into the TDU test by the Tracking Test Secretary. Dogs not holding VST title will be given priority for entry into the VST test by the Tracking Test Secretary.

All persons submitting entries are invited to attend the drawing.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, an ALTERNATE list will be drawn subject to the same preferences set forth above. The alternates will be advised of their positions on the alternate list and given an opportunity to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternate entry fees will be refunded unless the alternate actually participates in the test. Entry fees will also be refunded to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. If the LIMIT FOR ENTRIES is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TDU equals 1 VST.

A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test (TDU) for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test, certifying that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test that is equivalent in complexity to a TD or TDU test.

RESULTS OF THE DRAW will be e-mailed, the morning after the draw, to entrants who give an e-mail address on their entry form. WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS and the Judging Program will also be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, **please notify the Test Secretary by e-mail at calongloria@comcast.net, or (509)328-8420.**

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate. The Test Secretary must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. These dogs will be given the last tracks and will not be allowed in the tracking area until just prior to running their tracks.

THE TRACKING TEST SITE ("Site") will open at 7:00 a.m., September 23, 2018 Refreshments will be furnished. The DRAWING FOR TDU TRACKS will be at 8:00 a.m. The DRAWING FOR VST TRACKS will be at 10:00 a.m. The first track will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentee(s) among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

The test will be held on school campuses.

BY THEIR PRESENCE at the Site, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Test Committee and Judges. The Spokane Dog Training Club, the Tracking Test Committee, and the landowners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any dog or person on the Site or loss, damage or injury to any dog or person travelling to or from the Site.

Dogs not actually participating will go where instructed and all dogs will be kept on LEASH. Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs and for keeping the Site clean.

AWARDS: All competitors who pass this test will be awarded their tracking glove and a 5-window picture frame with pictures of their dog.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACKING SITE: The major interstate connecting Seattle and Coeur d'Alene to Spokane is I-90, GPS coordinates of the tracking site are 47.673952, -117.466975.

Westbound from Coeur d'Alene, take I-90 to the Maple St. exit (Exit 280A). Turn right onto S. Walnut St. Go 0.2 miles and keep left onto the Maple St. Bridge. Go 1.7 miles on Maple St. then turn left onto Northwest Blvd. Go 0.7 miles then turn left onto T.J. Meenach Drive. Go 1.3 miles, past Spokane Falls Community College to Elliot Drive. Turn right onto Elliot Drive, then make an immediate right turn into parking lot P6. The tracking test meeting site is in the southwest corner of parking lot P6.

Eastbound from Seattle/Ritzville, take I-90 Take the Maple St./Lincoln St. exit (Exit 280). Turn left onto S. Walnut St. Go 0.2 miles and keep left onto the Maple St. Bridge. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
