Since each dog is an individual, this goal is best achieved when the owner learns to understand their dog and to constantly adjust their training to the needs of their partner.

She has given seminars throughout the Western states as well as in other countries. Every seminar is unique, designed with the needs of the participants in mind. In order to accomplish this, everyone with a working spot will need to fill out a questionnaire so the seminar can be customized. Groups or individuals on the floor will be there to work out specific problems and the working groups are small to give everyone a chance to receive individual help.
