CLOSING DATE for these tests is Thursday, October 16th, 2025, 5:00 p.m., after which time entries cannot be accepted.

ENTRY FEE: TDX: \$120 / TD: \$60 (US funds) which includes a .50 AKC Recording Fee and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Fees must accompany all entries. Make checks or money orders payable to SDTC. Mail entries and fees to: Janet Hamilton, Test Secretary, 2825 S. Kendall St, Spokane, WA. 99224-5060. Only one AKC entry form will be accepted for each dog.

OWNERS are responsible for errors in entry forms, regardless of who may make such errors.

All entries will be accepted until the official closing date. A DRAWING will be held at the Spokane Dog Training Club, 2620 N. Locust, Spokane, Washington, on October 16th, at 6:30 p.m. to determine which entries will participate in the test. The drawing will be random among those entries received, except that preference will be given to dogs that have not previously earned a TDX for the TDX test or not previously earned a TD for the TD test. All persons submitting entries are invited to attend the drawing.

When the advertised limit has been drawn, an ALTERNATE list will be drawn subject to the same preferences set forth above. The alternates will be advised of their positions on the alternate list and given an opportunity to be at the test site in case of absent dogs. Alternate entry fees will be refunded unless the alternate actually participates in the test. Entry fees will also be refunded to any confirmed entry that does not participate in the test, provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the day of the test and provided that an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal. If the LIMIT FOR ENTRIES is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged at the ratio of 2 TD equals 1 TDX.

A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test, certifying that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test that is equivalent in complexity to a TD test.

RESULTS OF THE DRAW will be e-mailed, the morning after the draw, to entrants who give an e-mail address on their entry form. WRITTEN ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS and the Judging Program will also be mailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries. Should an acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, **please notify the Test Secretary by e-mail at fishcamp11@comcast.net, or (509)844-5426.**

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate. The Test Secretary must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. These dogs will be given the last tracks and will not be allowed in the tracking area until just prior to running their tracks.

THE TRACKING TEST SITE ("Site") will open at 9:00 a.m., October 26, 2025. The DRAWING FOR TD TRACKS will be at 9:30 a.m. The DRAWING FOR TDX TRACKS will be at 10:30 a.m. The first track will be run as soon thereafter as it has aged the proper length of time. In the event of any absentee(s) among the confirmed entries, the next alternate, in catalog order, who is present, will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

TRACKING COVER: The TD Test will be on grassland of varying lengths with trees, sage brush and marshy areas. The TDX Test will be on grassland of varying length, with rock outcrops, gravel roads, fences, trees, sage brush and marshy areas. Cattle may be present on the test site.

BY THEIR PRESENCE at the Site, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Test Committee and Judges. The Spokane Dog Training Club, the Tracking Test Committee, and the landowners assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any dog or person on the Site or loss, damage or injury to any dog or person travelling to or from the Site.

Dogs not actually participating will go where instructed and all dogs will be kept on LEASH. Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs and for keeping the Site clean.

AWARDS will be presented to dogs passing the TD or TDX test.

AWARDS: All competitors who pass this test will be awarded their tracking glove and a 5-window picture frame with pictures of their dog.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRACKING SITE: From I-90 take the Sprague exit (#245). West bound go left from the exit ramp, east bound turn right off the exit ramp. Go ¼ mile into Sprague and turn right at the corner by the Chevron station on 4th Street. Go a very short block and turn right again on "B" Street, and then go a couple blocks and turn right onto 1st Street. (For each of these turns you will be following the brown signs pointing to Columbia Basin Trails State Park). After the third right turn, go ¼ mile and watch for the tracking sign on the left side of the road. Turn left at the tracking sign, cross the railroad tracks and follow the gravel road through the gray gate and up the hill. **Use EXTREME care crossing the railroad tracks.** The staging area is ½ mile from the gate.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
