ENTRIES OPEN – 8:00 am Wednesday, March 18, 2026. No entries will be accepted prior to this time.

ENTRIES CLOSE – 8:00 pm Wednesday, April 29, 2026 or when entry limits are reached. No Entry will be accepted, canceled, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6, of the Dog Show Rules.

Per AKC regulations, entries automatically close when limits have been reached, even if this occurs before the official closing date. However, the club will maintain a wait list up until 8:00 PM on Friday, May 8, 2026 as permitted by AKC regulations. If an entry is withdrawn prior to that time and is replaced by a wait-listed entry, the full entry fee for the withdrawn entry will be refunded. All entries, including those placed on the wait list, MUST have been received by the published closing date of Wednesday, April 29 at 8:00 PM.

Obedience: Ascending order on Saturday, starting with 4", and Descending order on Sunday, starting with 16".

Regular Obedience classes will run in the order: Utility B/ Preferred Utility – Utility A – Open B/ Preferred Open – Open A – Novice B – Novice A

*Optional Titling Obedience classes will run in the following order **AFTER** the completion of Rally judging: Graduate Open – Versatility – Graduate Novice – Beginner Novice B – Beginner Novice A.*

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium list.

TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entries close at 10819 E Nora Ave, Spokane Valley, WA at 8:00 pm, Wednesday, April 29, 2026. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors MUST make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds. All checks and money orders should be made payable to Spokane Dog Training Club or SDTC and mailed to Trial Secretary, Neele Ammon, 10819 E Nora Ave, Spokane Valley, WA 99206.

AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RECORDING FEE: A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE (Obed. Reg. Chapt. 1, Section 3). The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will be refunded for BITCHES THAT COME IN SEASON after the closing date, provided that written notice is given to the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF JUDGING for the day. REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change, bitches in season or cancellations made prior to entry closing will be mailed to the Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE TRIAL.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

JUDGING: No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Trial. DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED. There is no provision for unentered dogs. The judging will start promptly as specified in entry confirmation. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class. Move ups are allowed at this trial according to AKC Regulations.

ACKNOWLEDGMENTS: Entries will be acknowledged after entries close, with acknowledgment and judging program sent to e-mail address on entry. If you wish to receive a hard copy please send a self-addressed stamped envelope to Neele Ammon, 10819 E Nora Ave, Spokane Valley, WA 99206. LOSS OR DAMAGE: The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this Trial. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

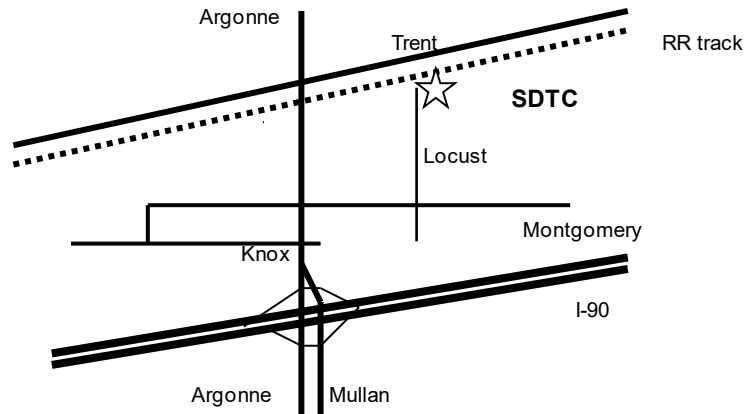

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE



Take I-90 to exit 287 (Argonne). Go north on Mullan (one-way, becomes Argonne two-way just north of the freeway). Turn RIGHT on Montgomery. Turn LEFT on Locust (one block past the traffic light at the Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store). There is no light at Locust. Locust ends at the RR tracks; SDTC is on the right at the end of the street.

PARKING INFORMATION (see map at right)

Some parking is available adjacent to the club building on the west (entrance side) and north (RR tracks) sides, in the cul-de-sac at the end of Locust, and along the east side of Locust. Parking is permitted in the gravel area on the east (street) side of Spokane Gymnastics, and in the lot northeast of Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store (behind Snap Fitness).

IMPORTANT!!! PLEASE DO NOT PARK in the lots on the North, South, and West sides of Spokane Gymnastics; those spaces are for their employees and clients. In addition, large trucks delivering to Yoke's Market must pass through the area on the north side of Spokane Gymnastics, and they need sufficient clearance. We want to maintain good relations with our neighbors, so it is important that we do not interfere with their activities. **If you are parked in a prohibited area, you WILL be asked to move your vehicle. Persons who do not comply with such requests may be subject to an Event Committee hearing, and vehicles parked in those locations may be towed.** We do have several designated spots for persons with a handicapped parking permit.

The SDTC parking lot does not have sufficient space for motor homes.

No overnight parking is available at the show site. There is no charge for day parking.

EXHIBITOR CRATING

Although we try to verify motel information, policies and ownerships may change, so we suggest that you check a facility's pet policy when making reservations.

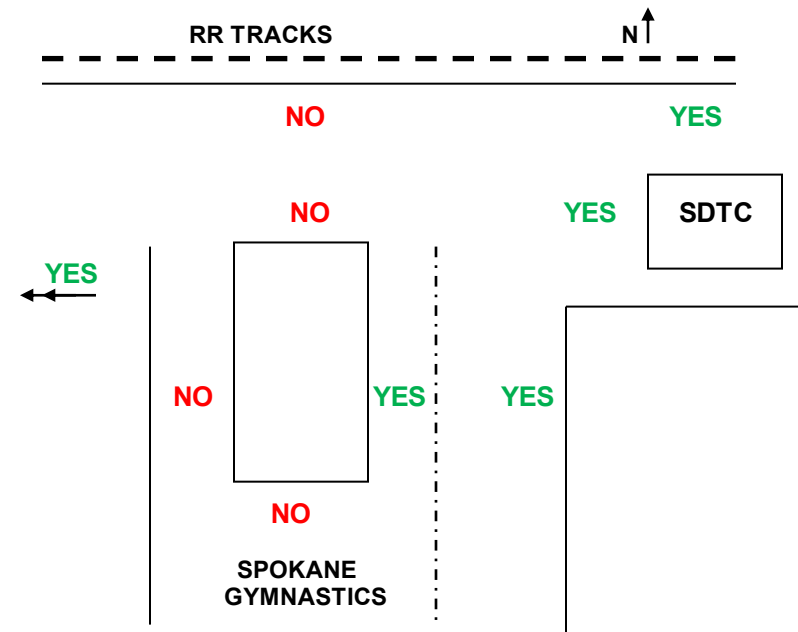

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this Obedience Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Obedience Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or trial secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Obedience Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this Obedience Trial, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniels (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collies (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles).

(Actual owners) A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (for complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
