#### TRIAL REGULATIONS

**ENTRY INFORMATION:** Entries close at 10819 E Nora Ave, Spokane Valley, WA at 8:00 pm, Friday, May 2, 2025. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors MUST make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds. All checks and money orders should be made payable to Spokane Dog Training Club and mailed to Trial Secretary, Neele Ammon, 10819 E Nora Ave, Spokane Valley, WA 99206.

**AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RECORDING FEE:** A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE see Obed. Reg. Chapt. 1, Section 3. The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for DUPLICATE ENTRIES or OVERPAYMENTS. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open, or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Entry fees will be refunded for BITCHES THAT COME IN SEASON after the closing date, provided that written notice is given to the Trial Secretary PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF JUDGING for the day. REFUNDS for cancellations due to judge change, bitches in season or cancellations made prior to entry closing will be mailed to the Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE TRIAL.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.**

**JUDGING:** No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those regularly entered in the Trial. DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED. There is no provision for unentered dogs. The judging will start promptly as specified in entry confirmation. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. The Club will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will NOT wait for any dog holding up a class. Move ups are allowed at this trial according to AKC Regulations.

**ACKNOWLEDGMENTS:** Entries will be acknowledged after entries close, with acknowledgment and judging program sent to e-mail address on entry. ## ~\*~ Rally Teams ~\*~

AKC Rally Teams is a dog sport event where groups of handlers and their dogs work together as a team to navigate a **Rally Novice** course. Unlike the individual format of traditional AKC Rally, this event involves multiple teams (**consisting of 4 dogs and handlers**) working in unison to perform a series of obedience exercises and maneuvers. The teams follow a course that includes different rally signs or stations, each representing a specific task like heeling, sitting, or performing specific turns.

The main goal of AKC Rally Teams is to demonstrate teamwork, coordination, and communication among all the handlers and dogs. Each dog-handler team is judged individually on their execution of the tasks at their respective stations, but the success of the overall team depends on how well they move together and maintain a consistent flow throughout the course.

The event emphasizes cooperation, as handlers and dogs must be in sync with each other and the rest of the team. It's an exciting and dynamic format that promotes camaraderie and mutual support while showcasing both the obedience skills of the dogs and the handlers' ability to work in a group setting. This is a great opportunity for dog owners to engage in a team-oriented dog sport, fostering a sense of community and shared achievement.

The cost is \$5.00 per dog, and the dog does not need to be entered in anything else.

**Important: Please fill out a separate official entry form for each dog entered. The entry fee applies to each dog in the team and does not count for the entire team. Please include a note informing us who is part of your team.**

## ~\*~ Rally Pairs ~\*~

AKC Rally Pairs is a fun and unique event in the world of dog sports, organized by the American Kennel Club (AKC). It is a variation of traditional AKC Rally, but with a twist: two dog-handler teams work together as a pair. In this event, each team of two dogs and their handlers navigates a series of rally stations in a **Rally Novice** Course that involve various obedience exercises, like heeling, sitting, and performing specific movements, while maintaining control and communication.

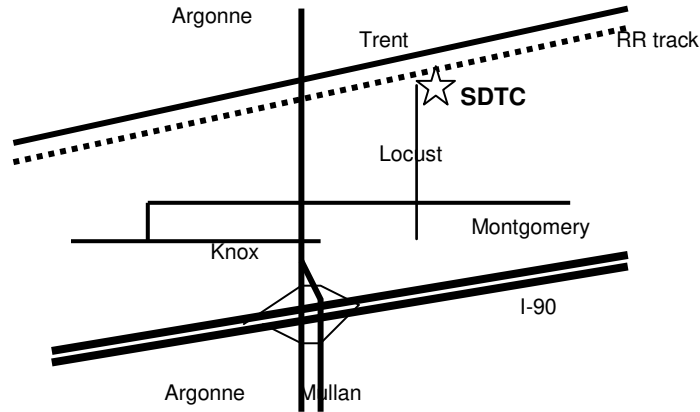
The key difference in Rally Pairs is that both teams must work in synchronization. Handlers and their dogs perform the course together, often mirroring each other's movements and actions, which adds a level of teamwork and timing. Each dog-handler team is judged on their individual performance, as well as how well they coordinate and cooperate with the other team.

Rally Pairs is a fun way to showcase the bond between dogs and handlers while also highlighting teamwork and obedience skills in a less competitive and more supportive environment than traditional dog sports. It's a great way for dog owners to engage with others in a positive, community-focused activity.

The cost is \$5.00 per dog, and the dog does not need to be entered in anything else.

**Important: Please fill out a separate official entry form for each dog entered. The entry fee applies to each dog in the pair and does not count for the entire team.**

## DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE



Take I-90 to exit 287 (Argonne). Go north on Mullan (one-way, becomes Argonne two-way just north of the freeway). Turn **RIGHT** on Montgomery. Turn **LEFT** on Locust (one block past the traffic light at the Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store). There is no light at Locust. Locust ends at the RR tracks; SDTC is on the right at the end of the street.

### PARKING INFORMATION (see map at right)

Some parking is available adjacent to the club building on the west (entrance side) and north (RR tracks) sides, in the cul-de-sac at the end of Locust, and along the east side of Locust. Parking is permitted in the gravel area on the east (street) side of Spokane Gymnastics, and in the lot northeast of Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store (behind Snap Fitness).

**IMPORTANT!!! PLEASE DO NOT PARK** in the lots on the North, South, and West sides of Spokane Gymnastics; those spaces are for their employees and clients. In addition, large trucks delivering to Yoke's Market must pass through the area on the north side of Spokane Gymnastics, and they need sufficient clearance. We want to maintain good relations with our neighbors, so it is important that we do not interfere with their activities. **If you are parked in a prohibited area, you WILL be asked to move your vehicle. Persons who do not comply with such requests may be subject to an Event Committee hearing, and vehicles parked in those locations may be towed.** We do have several designated spots for persons with a handicapped parking permit.

The SDTC parking lot does not have sufficient space for motor homes.

No overnight parking is available at the show site. There is no charge for day parking.

## EXHIBITOR CRATING

We will have designated areas adjacent to the ring for personal crates. Crating is available both inside and outside.

Although we try to verify motel information, policies and ownerships may change, so we suggest that you check a facility's pet policy when making reservations.

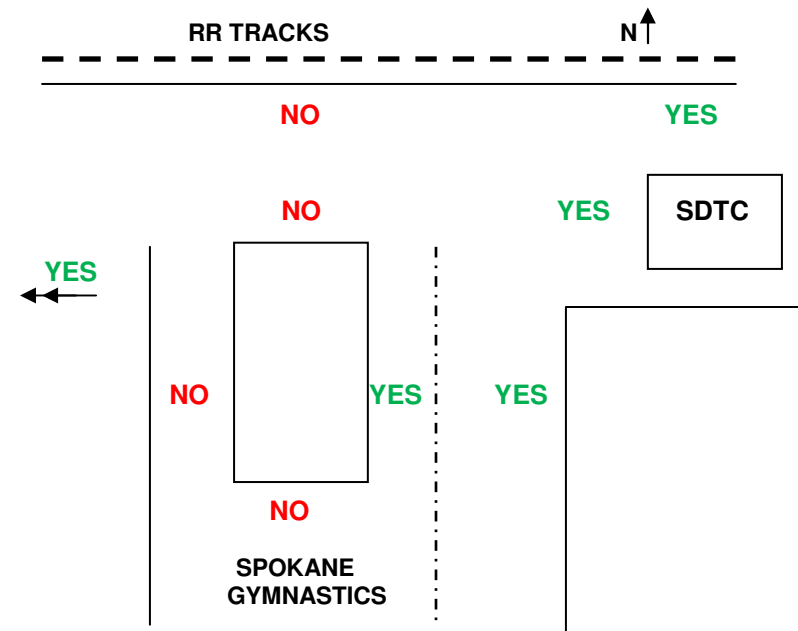
