The American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern these Shows and Exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Show Premium list.

TRIAL REGULATIONS

ENTRY INFORMATION: Entries close at 1121 S. Blake Rd, Spokane Valley, WA 99216-0625 at 5:00 pm, Wednesday, February 3, 2021. Fees must accompany entries. Canadian Exhibitors MUST make all checks and/or money orders payable in U.S. funds. All checks and money orders should be made payable to Spokane Dog Training Club and mailed to Trial Secretary, Rosie Banta, 1121 S. Blake Rd, Spokane Valley, WA 99216. **Entries delivered elsewhere will NOT be picked up or processed.**

AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB RECORDING FEE: A RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No entry will be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted and will be returned. **Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side are NOT ACCEPTABLE see Obed. Reg. Chapt. 1, Section 3.** The Club assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or the owner's agent, or if the dog is entered in a class in which it is not eligible to compete. **THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE COMPLETENESS OF ANY ENTRY RESTS SOLELY WITH THE ENTRANT.**

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for **DUPLICATE ENTRIES** or **OVERPAYMENTS**. The Secretary will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Please read attached COVID-19 information.

Entry fees will be refunded for **BITCHES THAT COME IN SEASON** after the closing date, provided that written notice is given to the Trial Secretary **PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF JUDGING** for the day. **REFUNDS** for cancellations due to judge change, bitches in season or cancellations made prior to entry closing will be mailed to the Exhibitor or Agent **AFTER THE TRIAL**.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY FEE. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor or agent may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

JUDGING: No dogs will be allowed in the show area except those entered in the Trial. **DO NOT BRING ANY DOGS THAT ARE NOT ENTERED.** There is no provision for dogs not entered in the trial. The judging will start promptly as specified in the entry confirmation. **THERE WILL BE NO CRATING IN THE BUILDING AND THE NUMBER OF PERSONS ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING AT ANY TIME WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COVID-19 DIRECTIVES IN PLACE AT THE TIME OF THE TRIAL.**

The Club will not be responsible and is not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class; it is not the responsibility of the ring steward to locate any dog, its owner or its agent when the dog's presence is needed in the judging ring. Judges will **NOT** wait for any dog holding up a class. Move ups are allowed at this trial according to AKC Regulations.

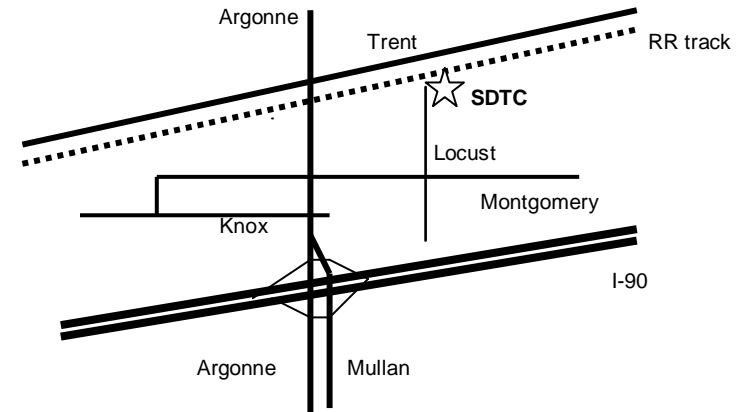

Take I-90 to exit 287 (Argonne). Go north on Mullan (one-way, becoming Argonne two-way just north of the freeway).

Turn **RIGHT** on Montgomery.

Turn **LEFT** on Locust (one block past the traffic light at the Yoke's Fresh Market grocery store). There is no light at Locust.

Locust ends at the RR tracks; SDTC is on the right at the end of the street.

Some parking is available adjacent to the club building and on the street and parking is permitted in the lot northeast of Yoke's Fresh Market. **Do not** park in the Spokane Gymnastics lots; your vehicle may be towed. The SDTC parking lot does not have sufficient space for motor homes.

Rosettes will be given for High in Trial and High Combined in obedience, High Combined and High Triple Qualifying in rally, and first through fourth place in each class. Green ribbons will be given for qualifying scores. Title ribbons will be given for those earning a new title

Rally will be limited to 45 entries per rally event. Obedience will be limited to 7 hours of judging.

COVID-19 Information For This Trial

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. By attending these events, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

We hope that we will be able to have these trials in February but we do not know what may happen over the winter. However, in the event that Washington State COVID-19 guidelines make holding this trial not possible, your entry fee will be returned minus any AKC fees we may need to pay.

MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES BY EVERYONE IN THE BUILDING. NO EXCEPTIONS! If you are not able to do this, please do not enter the trial as you will not be allowed to show your dog.

The number of Stewards will be reduced to make sure our occupancy limit for COVID-19 is not exceeded. In order to limit the number of people in the building, we will be using cones in place of people for the figure 8 exercise. Stewards will wear gloves when handling gloves, articles etc.

There will be separate doors, clearly marked, for entering and exiting the building.

There will be **NO CRATING** in the building so please be prepared to wait in your car until your class is called. We realize that February weather may not be pleasant so please come prepared to make sure both you and your dog stay warm.

A limited number of handlers will be allowed in the building at a time for briefings. Running order for each class will be posted outside and it will be your

responsibility to be ready with your dog. A limited number of handlers will be allowed into the building with their dog prior to showing in the ring.

At this time, we plan on having the Utility A class run first thing in the morning. That way, the Utility A handlers and dogs will be able to leave the trial site and those who are trying for UDX legs will be able to show in Utility B followed by Open B without waiting too long.

Ribbons will be distributed differently. Qualifiers will **NOT** be called back into the building to receive their ribbons. Arrangements will be made to get them to you by the end of the trial. Please make sure your cell phone number is legible and on your entry form . No ribbons will be mailed.

All Washington State COVID-19 directives in place at the time of this trial **MUST** be followed.
